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Conclusions

- 1) By working together and forming a common vision the Nordic and Baltic countries can better influence decisions at EU-level
- 2) The **Analysis on use cases in the geographical areas of close cross-border cooperation** was discussed and seen useful for communication and policy making purposes- also cost-benefit analysis could be done in these areas. Some useful links were provided for these purposes:
